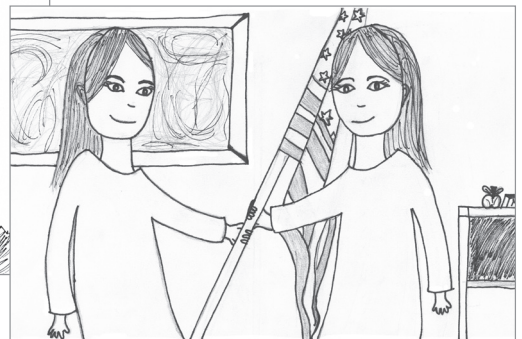
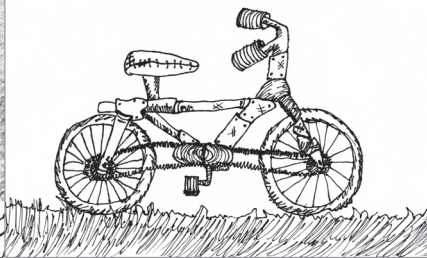
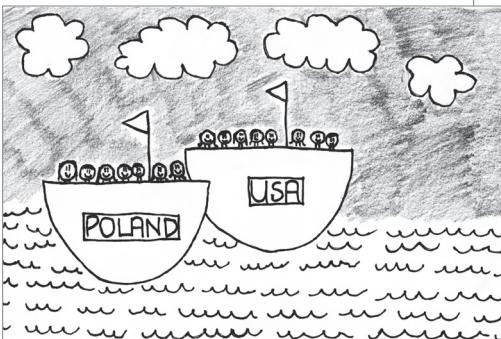


ECHOES FROM WORLD WAR II
